


#### Incidents by Hour for Date Range








Heat Map of all calls Scappoose Fire responded to in 2017






### NUMBER OF RESPONSES BY EACH VEHICLE


### NUMBER OF CALLS BY DAY OF THE WEEK



# CALLS BY TIME OF DAY









# March 2018 – Chief of Operations Monthly Report

- Image Trend, the High Plains replacement for our emergency reporting system is in process. Training is currently taking place on shift. FF Jeff Lockhart and FF Tim Hennigan are working to train our career staff and EMS only personnel. Training for volunteers will take place in the month of April. We have pushed the Go Live date to April 11, 2018 due to technical issues between Image Trend and Tri-Tech.
- Crew Sense, another aspect of High Plains that deals with Personnel Rosters, vacation, sick leave, overtime, and general time accounting also is in process. Finance has paid for the Crew Sense subscription, crew rosters have been built. Training the officers and A/L's is the next step in the process. Working with Local 3215 to develop call back and overtime selection procedures. Update: Local 3215 is working with Crew Sense on the OT call back permissions and procedures.
- Budget Items Operations has submitted requests for items in the 2018/19 budget, some items such as Personal Protective Equipment, hose, saws, wildland equipment, and other items have been placed into the budget as a request(s).
- Ambulance Only personnel are currently completing their Field Training Program
  component per Chief Coombs. This process is dependent upon the individual training
  with the crews and learning the aspects of the job. It will vary between individuals on
  how fast they complete the process.
- CAD development: CAD and the new Tri-Tech system are working to varying degrees of success. We are working to correct issues as the y appear with Tri-Tech and CCOM personnel.
- Wildland/Conflagration response reimbursement: This year's wildland/mutual aid
  response was large and lengthy. We have begun billing for our equipment and manpower
  to the State. It is the goal of the Administration to re-invest these funds into needed
  equipment, supplies, and items that would ultimately come from the general fund in
  some form or another. When we begin to receive our reimbursement we will present our
  options to the Fire Chief and Board for considerations.

# **EMS Office Activity**

Our first group of part-time single role EMS personnel began in March. They received four days of orientation training prior to beginning the Field Training Evaluation Program (FTEP.) Experience ranges from a newly licensed EMT to a paramedic that has worked several years on a 911 ambulance.

CRFR line personnel have begun working with the ImageTrend. Feedback has been very positive. The CAD/ImageTrend link is now active and CCOM has been involved to assure information is properly 'mapped.' Training for billing personnel is underway and we have been working on exporting information to billing software. We are also confirming that our data meets all state EMS reporting requirements. Our go live date is April 11<sup>th</sup>.

Other duties included assisting with the recruit academy, working with the company officers to assure daily observation reports (DORs) are completed, an Oregon Health Authority inspection at SFD and completing a line safety officer course in Salem.

Foresters Financial

This memo recommends that the Board approve Foresters Financial as a 457 Retirement Plan vendor for Scappoose Fire District.

The District's current vendor is the Oregon Savings Growth Plan (OSGP). It has a balanced variety of good no-load funds plus an independent option, and visits upon request to provide financial investment classes. As the OSGP staff emphasize, they only offer education and not financial advice. This works well for individuals confident enough to make their own choices or who have a relationship with an external financial adviser.

However, employees today bear the primary responsibility for organizing an adequate long-term retirement and solving other financial concerns such as children's education, life insurance and long-term care. Many people require assistance with this, and employers can help by offering a vendor with more comprehensive services for those who choose to pay for it.

On March 9, eight staff met with Sara Rohne-Tanner, a Foresters Financial Services representative. Sara grew up in Knappa and has served many local governments and their employees for 25 years. Chief Greisen and I both have personal experience with her, and also know of her excellent reputation with many other investors. Where many other companies promise in-depth financial advising and then fade into the woodwork, Sara actually provides the service year after year. The staff who attended her presentation were impressed with the information she shared. Sara's contractual relationship with her clients adheres to a fiduciary standard which requires her to put her clients' interests above her own.

Foresters is an international financial services provider with \$28 billion of funds under management. It has been in business since 1930. It is an offshoot of the Independent Order of Foresters, a fraternal organization deeply committed to charitable works within the communities they serve. Foresters offers front load funds, and the onetime fees start at 5.5% and scale down from there as the client's asset balance increases. While this is expensive compared to the OSGP, Foresters provides comprehensive services that the OSGP cannot.

Several employees have requested that the District add Foresters Financial as a 457 plan vendor. Please let me know if you have any questions.
